High Performance Masonry: Meeting Insulation Choices, Options and Requirements for Masonry Buildings

Envelope performance continues to be a topic of importance for the designer looking to find the best methods to balance a building's energy usage. As systems are analyzed to address the reduction of internal loads, the design of the building envelope should be incorporated as part of the building's strategy for energy conservation. While there are many components impacting energy conservation in the envelope, it appears that insulation has moved to the center of the conversation. This seminar will focus on the connections between sustainability and high performance masonry walls, specifically looking at ASHRAE 90.1 and today's insulation requirements for building envelopes. We will discuss how masonry MORE than meets industry standards as well as how thermal mass contributions from masonry help to enhance the whole building performance.
