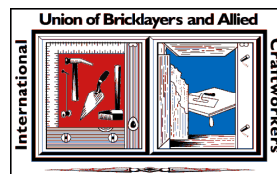

Flashing Upgrade:

The overall concept is to convey a greater understanding of masonry cavity wall drainage systems, with the goal of creating a better masonry environment, and reinforce the design community's confidence in BAC craftworkers' abilities. It is not intended to teach how to install the assemblies, but to update the entire construction industry on best practices. Key elements include:

- Building code requirements
- Responsibility of designer and installer, with focus on the life cycle of the building
- Awareness and advantages of the available systems and materials
- Reinforcement of the fact that the components are not just pieces, but perform functions to keep the wall "healthy"
- Specific function of flashings, weeps/vents, drainage planes, air spaces, and masonry units as related to the performance of the wall
- Understanding of interface of materials
- Review of new materials and technologies
- Stress the importance of high quality BAC training and craftsmanship
